SHAMROCK HILLS CUSTOM IRELAND TOUR

Wed, May 21 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Thu, May 22 DUBLIN ARRIVAL

After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Next, set off on an orientation drive around Dublin city center. See the main thoroughfares of O'Connell Street, Nassau Street and some lovely public parks as you pass by many historical sites. Stop to tour Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft of Guinness. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and enjoy the balance of the day free to sightsee, shop and dine on your own.

OVERNIGHT: ASHLING HOTEL, DUBLIN

Fri, May 23 EPIC IRELAND

This morning, visit EPIC Ireland, which celebrates the dramatic story of the spread of Irish culture around the globe, and how Ireland has changed throughout the years. Head back to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the afternoon at leisure. Later in the day, you might like to freshen up before this evening's festivities.

Tonight, head to Taylors Three Rock for quality Irish food that is accompanied with lively music and dance.

OVERNIGHT: ASHLING HOTEL, DUBLIN

Sat, May 24 DUBLIN TO CORK

Leaving Dublin, travel into County Tipperary for photos of the Rock of Cashel. These majestic church ruins are clustered high on a limestone outcrop overlooking the surrounding countryside. Next, journey into Cork and embark on a panoramic tour of the main areas of Ireland's second largest city. Cork is built on many hills with many steeply sloping streets. See Shandon Church, which dates to 1722. Also, view the Gothic-revival St. Finbarr's Cathedral, named for the patron saint of the city. Transfer to your nearby hotel, check in and settle into your room. Tonight, join your group for dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: RIVER LEE HOTEL, CORK

Sun, May 25 OLD MIDDLETON DISTILLERY

Today, drive into Middleton and stop to visit the Old Middleton Distillery. While here, enjoy the Apprentice tour and discover how whiskey is made as you walk through the fully functioning distillery. At the end of your tour, enjoy a premium whiskey tasting along with a sample straight from the cask. Return to your hotel in Cork, where the remainder of the day is free for independent exploring and dining.

OVERNIGHT: RIVER LEE HOTEL, CORK

Mon, May 26 BLARNEY CASTLE

Departing Cork, journey into Blarney, where you can climb the battlements of Blarney Castle and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Then, visit the Blarney Woollen Mills, which has an excellent range of Irish products. You will also have time to browse around the village, charmingly set around a large village green. After, set off to explore a section of the breathtaking Ring of Kerry. The scenic drive will take you to plenty of stops at strategic locations, where you can take photos. Along the way, journey into Kenmare and stop to enjoy some time at leisure. Then, continue your drive to Moll's Gap, which overlooks the three lakes, before traveling to Ladies' View for more spectacular view of Killarney's lakes and mountains. Transfer to your hotel in Killarney, check in and settle into your room. In the evening, meet your fellow travelers in the hotel restaurant for a delicious meal.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: SCOTTS HOTEL, KILLARNEY

Tue, May 27 DINGLE PENINSULA DRIVE

This morning, embark on a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through the grounds of the Killarney National Park. After, set off to discover the beauties of the Dingle Peninsula, once described by the National Geographic Traveler as "the most beautiful place on earth." Wed, May 28 CLIFFS OF MOHER

After breakfast, journey into Listowel and stop at John B. Keane's Bar, which is where the author who the pub is named after, wrote many of his famous masterpieces. While here, enjoy a cup of tea or Irish coffee along with fresh baked scones. Next, travel into Tarbert and take a short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary. Then, drive along the coast of scenic County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most beloved, natural landmarks. See magical vistas, overlooking the shimmering Atlantic Ocean along with Ireland's Western coastline. Continue your travel into Galway and join a local guide for a gentle walking tour of Galway. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and the narrow streets. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and enjoy some free time before dining in the hotel restaurant with your group.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: ARDILAUN HOTEL, GALWAY

Thu, May 29 CONNEMARA SEACRUISE

Today, drive into Leenane and take a short catamaran cruise aboard the "Connemara Lady" through Killary Harbour, Ireland's only fjord. Enjoy the onboard commentary as you admire the views from this narrow inlet, which is surrounded by hills and cliffs. While onboard, enjoy an Irish coffee with your fellow travelers. Then, continue on to visit Kylemore Abbey for a tour of the elegant mansion and church, set beside a tranquil lake. Learn of the tales of tragedy, romance and royal visits. Also, walk through the magical Victorian walled garden. Return to your hotel in Galway for a free evening.

Fri, May 30 ATLANTIC SHEEPDOGS

Leaving Galway, travel to visit Atlantic Sheepdogs, where you will have the opportunity to experience farm life and see some of the world's smartest sheepdogs, working in their natural environment. Next, journey into Belleek and stop to visit the Belleek Pottery Factory to see how skilled craftspeople form and decorate clay to produce delicate porcelain masterpieces. Continue your drive into Derry, check into your hotel and settle into your room. Tonight, dine with your group in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: EVERGLADES HOTEL, DERRY

Sat, May 31 GIANT'S CAUSEWAY

This morning, visit the Giant's Causeway, an impressive area of hexagonal columns formed over 60 million years ago by cooling lava, which has given rise to many legends. After, journey into Bushmills to visit Bushmills Distillery, which is Ireland's oldest whiskey distillery. See how whiskey is distilled and then try a sample at the end of your tour. Head back to your hotel in Derry and spend some time at leisure before a festive evening with your group.

Tonight, head to the Walled City Brewery, which has offered locally flavored craft and artisan beers for over a decade. While here, enjoy a flight of beer along with a classic Irish dinner with your fellow travelers.

OVERNIGHT: EVERGLADES HOTEL, DERRY

Sun, June 1 AFTERNOON AT LEISURE

Departing Derry, travel into Kingscourt and check into the beautiful Cabra Castle Hotel. Spend the remainder of the afternoon at leisure to enjoy Cabra Castle's exceptional service. Experience what it's like living as a "Landed Gentry," while also surrounded by wonderful scenery and complete luxury. You may wish to play a round of golf, horseback ride or even fish.
